ORDINANCE NO. 4313

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO RESPOND TO CERTAIN CIVIL INFRACTIONS.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 12.45.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.45.040 Failure to respond—Unlawful.

It is unlawful for a person who has been issued a civil infraction relating to parking, standing, stopping, or pedestrian infractions, defined by city ordinance, to fail to respond in the manner directed on the notice of infraction. Unless otherwise specified by state law or city ordinance, the penalty for such failure to respond shall be thirtytwenty-five dollars. This penalty is in addition to penalties imposed for the underlying infraction.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
